

**JETSET LEVEL TWO
LISTENING TEST
JET VERSION 15
TRANSCRIPT**

(Part one: 1 boy and 1 girl)

"JETSET from Pearson LCCI Level 2 Listening test, Junior version, version 15."

"Do not start this test until the supervisor tells you to start."

"This test has 20 questions. There are 2 parts; both parts have 10 questions. You will hear each recording twice."

"You will have 2 minutes to look at the questions for each part, then you will listen and try to choose the correct answers to the questions."

"Mark your answers on the answer sheet."

"You will then hear each part again and try to answer any questions you may have missed."

"Now look at the front of your answer sheet and see how to mark your answers."

"Now wait until the supervisor tells you to open your question paper."

"You now have 2 minutes to look at the questions for Part 1."

(2 minute pause)

"Part 1 – Listen to the recording, read the statements and select True (A) or False (B). Mark your answers on your answer sheet."

"You will hear the recording twice."

(3 second pause)

(Note to V & A – Even though the speakers are from Germany & Italy, the voices should NOT have such accents as this would not be appropriate for L2)

Part One

Hans: Hello, my name is Hans and I come from Germany. What is your name?

(3 second pause)

Patsy: Hello, my name is Patrizia, but all my friends call me Patsy.

(3 second pause)

Hans: Where are you from Patsy?

(3 second pause)

Patsy: I'm from Italy, but I came to London last year with my family. My mother is English and my father is Italian. She is a librarian and she works here now.

(3 second pause)

Hans: Is all your family in London?

(3 second pause)

Patsy: No, my brother, Paulo, lives in Rome with my grandmother. He's at university. My sister, Lucia, lives at home with us but my father doesn't. He lives in Italy. He has got a ski school there. Where do you live?

(3 second pause)

Hans: I live at home with my parents, my brother and my sister. We came to England six months ago. My parents teach German in my school. We live in a flat; it is next to the school.

(3 second pause)

Patsy: Are you the oldest in your family?

(3 second pause)

Hans: No, my brother is older than me. His name is Tomas and he is 15, I am 11 and my sister, Lana, is 6. I go to the same school as my brother but my sister goes to a different school.

(3 second pause)

Patsy: Your English is good. Are your parents English?

(3 second pause)

Hans: No, they're not, they're German. But I studied English in my primary school for six years. Tomas also speaks good English but my sister doesn't. She is taking extra lessons in English; a teacher comes to our flat to teach her. Can your father speak English?

(3 second pause)

Patsy: He can speak a little. He tries to speak in English with the people who come to the ski school. They are surprised when they hear him – and sometimes they laugh because his English is not good, but my father is a very good ski teacher.

(3 second pause)

Hans: I took ski lessons in Austria last year. I am not a very good skier, but I like skiing a lot. Austria is a good place to ski. Can you ski?

(3 second pause)

Patsy: Yes I can. My dad gave me lessons. I started when I was two years old. I won a competition last year and I came first.

(3 second pause)

Hans: Oh that's good! You're so lucky that your father is a ski teacher. I want to take more lessons.

(3 second pause)

Patsy: Then come to Italy and you can learn to ski with my family. You and your family can stay at our house in Biella, and my father can give you all lessons.

(3 second pause)

Hans: Oh, yes please. But I don't know them.

(3 second pause)

Patsy: Well, you can meet them at my house tomorrow. My mum comes home at 4 o'clock so you can come at five. She likes meeting my friends!

(3 second pause)

Hans: Yes, I can do that – see you then..... *(Recording fades)*

"You will now hear the recording again."

Repeat Part 1

"End of Part 1."

"You now have 2 minutes to look at the questions for Part 2."

(2 minute pause)

(Female voice here)

"Part 2 - Read each question, listen to the recording and select the correct answer (A, B, C or D). Mark your answers on your answer sheet."

"You will hear the recording twice".

Hello, my name is Birgit, I am Swiss and I am from Geneva. Geneva is in the west of Switzerland. It's a big city and it is very close to France.

(3 second pause)

In the winter, the weather is very cold and in the summer the weather gets better but every day is different. Sometimes it's cold and sometimes it's warm but I always wear a jacket or coat. I like the winter because I can play football.

(3 second pause)

I am good at sport and I can play tennis, basketball and football. My friends and I play for a football team. We are very good. The team is called 'Geneva Gold'.

(3 second pause)

My best friend is Günter and he lives near my house. We play for the team on Mondays and Saturdays. At the end of the year there is a competition and we want to win.

(3 second pause)

We don't play for the team in the summer because my friends and I go on holiday with our families. But my friends and I always play in the playground next to our school.

(3 second pause)

(Male voice here)

Hello, my name is Marcus and I am Spanish. People think it is always warm in Spain, but in the winter it is often cold. I like winter because I can ski in the mountains. Every winter, I go skiing with my family. In the summer we stay at home and my Aunt Maria comes to stay.

(3 second pause)

I live in the south of Spain, in Malaga. In the summer it is very hot there and it never rains. I like summer the best. In the mornings it is nice and warm, but at lunchtime it gets very hot so I swim in the sea with my friends.

(3 second pause)

I see my friends every day and we chat and play games. I have lots of friends and they all live near my house. We also have long school holidays in the summer so I go to the beach. I go there every day for four or five hours.

(3 second pause)

On the beach there are many restaurants so we can buy pizza or pasta. Pizza Marguerita is my favourite; this is cheese and tomato. The pizza in Malaga is very good; I think it is the best in Spain. They do not cost a lot of money – only five euros.

(3 second pause)

When I get home from the beach I am very tired but I have a younger brother and he always wants to play games. I like my brother so I play with him for about an hour. He goes to bed at 8 o'clock and I go to bed at 9 o'clock.

"You will now hear the recording again."

Repeat Part 2

"End of Part 2."

"You now have an additional 5 minutes to transfer your answers to the OMR sheet."

(5 minute pause)

"That is the end of the test."
